University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada was considered by the Board of Governors and it was decided as under:-

"The Board of Governors considered the assessment report (May, 2012) and noted that MS(General Surgery) qualification is already recognized with 04(Four) seat(s) and decided to recommend that MS(General Surgery) qualification against increased intake from 04(Four) to 10(Ten) seat(s) granted by Dr. N.T.R.
