REPORT ON THE FUNCTIONING OF IMMUNISATION CLINIC

Kamineni Institute of Medical Sciences has its own immunization clinic conducted by Department of Paediatrics. The immunization clinic sessions are conducted on Wednesday and Saturday of every week. The clinic also provides vaccines for medical indications and to those who are exposed to occupational risk. . Also new optional vaccinations depending on the affordability of the parents are recommended. . Immunization clinic protocol is carried out as per the National Immunization Schedule. BCG vaccine , Oral Polio Vaccine, Inactivated Polio Vaccine , Hepatitis-B vaccine , DPT/DT vaccine , Tetanus toxoid ,Rota virus vaccine , MR vaccine, Haemophilus influenza type -B , Vitamin A . Institute also provides following vaccines as per Indian Academy of Paediatrics (IAP) schedule for the prevention of medical diseases.

The vaccines available are Pneumococcal vaccine , Hepatitis A vaccine , Varicella vaccine, MMR vaccine , Typhoid vaccine and HPV

All the vaccines are stored as per the WHO guidelines in Ice lined Refrigerator (ILR) and record of temperature is maintained vigilantly by staff nurse.

Vaccine Administration:- It is done by Teaching Staff and Postgraduate students of Paediatrics departments and record keeping regarding the vaccination that is vaccine, dosage, dose, number, site of vaccine administration, date of vaccination, details, of batch of vaccine and company or manufacture of the vaccine etc. is done by nursing staff and vaccinator.



Immunization card is provided to all the children at the first dose of Immunization and they carry the card on subsequent visits. After vaccination staff nurse briefs the parents about post vaccination care, regarding common side effects of vaccine and when to seek medical education if in case necessary , common helpline numbers, emergency medical service providers numbers and details are provide by Teaching Staff and Postgraduate students of Paediatrics departments along with giving nutritional advice and health education about preventing common childhood illness



Pulse Polio Immunization is conducted and all the children coming to paediatric OPD are immunized. We extend our services inside the campus and to nearby areas and vaccinate the children staying at Staff Quarters as well as children of nearby villages, in and around urban health centres. Vaccine carrier is available to carry the vaccine for outreach sessions. CRRIs and the post graduate doctors of community medicine take part in the Pulse Polio Immunization activity.



Immunization activities are also carried out in the Rural Health and Training Centre (RHTC) under the supervision of Lady Medical Officer (LMO) and Paediatrician. Every

year Paediatric Department celebrate Immunization week from 24th April- 30th April to create awareness among the patients and attenders about importance of Immunization.
